Social network analysis is an emerging tool in the evaluation of public health partnerships. It can also be a powerful resource for academic researchers in community-based participatory research partnerships.

Dr. Buchthal will present the results of a recent network study conducted with organizations in the Kalihi community, and discuss how network data is being used by community partners to identify assets, bridge community divides, and strengthen their efforts to build a healthier food environment for Kalihi residents.
