Now Accepting Fellowship Applications

The goal of the program is to increase the capacity of the workforce to conduct high quality patient-centered outcomes research (PCOR) and build training and long-term PCOR infrastructure at institutions with NIH-funded Research Centers in Minority Institutions (RCMIs).

Fellows will:

- Participate in a one-year fellowship with 1 month on-site experiential learning at the University of Pittsburgh
- Be immersed in multidisciplinary PCOR, working closely with stakeholder groups, methodology experts, and mentors to complete a research project
- Be required to devote at least 25% of their time (in addition to the 1 month in Pittsburgh)

Applicants should:

- Be postdocs or early to mid-career faculty
- Demonstrate interest in PCOR
- Have prior research training that includes introductory statistics and research methods
